BÅSTAD

Båstad is situated on the west coast, in the southern part of Sweden. The village is sheltered from the wind by a hill, which give the village and harbour a calm, tight atmosphere.

Båstad community has 5 000 permanent inhabitant but in the summer the area grow to more than 30 000 people. In 1905 Ludvig Nobel started to develop Båstad as a summer vacation destination, and have been popular since then.

ACCESS

Air. Local airport is Ängelholm (AGH) with 5-10 daily connections to Stockholm. Main airport is Copenhagen (CPH). In the arrival hall there is direct train connections to Båstad every hour. Travel time is 2 hrs.

Train. Båstad has a railway station on the main railway from Malmö to Gothenburg

Malmö-Båstad: 1hr 30 min

Gothenburg-Båstad: 1 hr 40 min

Road. Båstad is close to the main road along the coast. Malmö-Båstad: 1hr 10 min

Gothenburg-Båstad: 1 hr 40 min

Copenhagen Airport - Båstad 1 hr 30 min

RACING AREA

The race area is direct outside the harbour. There are no obstacles in the race area. Depth: 10-15 m. No or light current and no tide.

Wind changes from day to day, normally 5-10 m/s. Main wind direction is SW-NW. Wind from W and N gives steady wind and nice waves. Wind from S and E gives changing wind and flat water. A normal summer day gives a sea breeze in the afternoon from W-NW.
